ORDER

At the hearing held by this Court on January 29, 1998 to determine what further litigation would be necessary to resolve this matter, it was agreed by the parties that the present record was sufficient and that the Court could make a final determination. Accordingly, it is hereby

ORDERED that Defendants, their officers, agents, servants, employees, and attorneys and those persons in active concert or participation with them who receive actual notice of the Order by personal service or otherwise, shall be permanently enjoined from taking any adverse action against Plaintiff, including discharging Plaintiff from the United States Navy or otherwise hindering Plaintiff's Naval Service, on the basis of his alleged sexual orientation so long as Plaintiff is in compliance with 10 U.S.C. § 654 and relevant regulations as interpreted by this Court in its January 26, 1998 opinion; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall appear before this Court on March 4, 1998 at 10:00 in Courtroom 6 for a status conference to rule on Plaintiff's request for attorneys' fees and costs, with the parties' submissions on these matters being filed before that date, and to

consider any other matters that may be properly before the Court at that time.
